BLACK PEPPER

Global Market Scenario:

■ Black pepper markets across the globe have shown a mixed response throughout August 2022.

Black pepper markets in India had reported as slight upward trend in August due to firm domestic demand. Indian pepper price reported to be firm.

Black pepper prices in Indonesia remained stable during August 2022. Pepper crop in Indonesia is short and Indonesian Rupiah weakening against US Dollar has affected the price.

Black pepper prices in Sri Lanka have shown a down trend in August.



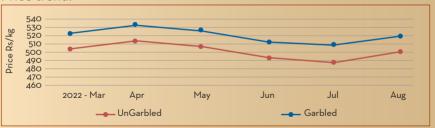
Black pepper prices in Vietnam were almost stable during the month due to less demand from China.

- Indian black pepper prices have shown a steady to firm trend in August.
- Prices are firming up due to festival season and good demand.
- · Crop is at its flowering and berry setting stages.
- Rainfall has been more than normal in the growing areas hence it can impact the crop production.
- Ungarbled pepper was traded at Rs. 500/kg whereas garbled pepper was traded at Rs. 522/kg levels at domestic markets

Crop Status & Market Trend:

- Chilli sowing is at final stages in major growing belts in Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.
- As per latest indications the crop sowing is expected to be short.
- Carry forward stocks of chilli in August 2022 is reported to be around 50 - 55 % less when compared to August 2021.
- · Current market price of other major varieties are:

341/334 chilli : Rs. 250 - 310/kg 5531 red : Rs. 250 - 290/kg

- Chilli cultivation area is reported to be short.
- · Transplantation of seedlings to farms are ongoing.
- Black thrips infestation damage has not been reported till now.
- Prices of all high colour and medium variety chilies have increased in domestic markets due to less stocks, huge demand associated with festival season.

- The erratic and heavy rains in the turmeric growing regions may have an impact on the yield of upcoming turmeric crop.
- Maharashtra has reported crop damages due to severe rains in the growing belts.
- Regular finger turmeric prices have seen a down trend in August due to less demand in domestic and international markets.

- Salem Finger is currently traded at Rs. 72 74/kg levels.
- Kocha availability is limited in domestic markets and prices remained downward.
- Panangali turmeric prices were also reported downward at main markets due to less demand.

INDONESIA

- Turmeric harvesting in Indonesia is ongoing, crop is reported to be short.
- Domestic and export demand of turmeric is low as of now.
