BLACK PEPPER

Global Market Scenario:

Black pepper markets across the globe have indicated a mixed response throughout September 2022. Pepper prices were affected as most currencies weakened against US Dollar.

Black pepper market in India were reported stable for most of September. Indian pepper prices came down towards the end of September due to the weakening of Indian Rupee against US Dollar.

Black pepper prices in Indonesia were reported stable in September. The exports continued to be reported lower as availability is limited.



Black pepper prices in Sri Lanka have indicated a stable trend in September.

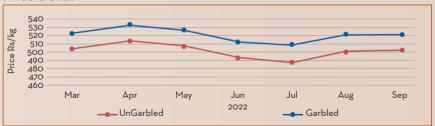
Black pepper prices in Vietnam were reported to be stable during the month due to less demand.

- Indian black pepper prices have indicated a steady trend mostly in September.
- Prices have shown a steady to downward trend towards the end of September.
- · Crop is at berry setting stage.
- Ungarbled pepper was traded at Rs. 500/kg whereas garbled pepper was traded at Rs. 520/kg levels at domestic markets.

Crop Status & Market Trend:

- Chilli sowing status in major growing belts in Karnataka 90 -95 % completed, Andhra Pradesh and Telangana -70-80 % completed.
- · Crop is at flowering stage in most of the early sown belts.
- As per trade sources the crop sowing is expected to be short.
- Farmers have gone for re-sowing in areas were crop damages were initially reported.
- Prices of Teja chilli variety have shown a stable to down trend in the domestic markets in September.
- · Current market price of other major varieties is:

341/334 chilli : Rs. 240 - 290/kg 5531 red : Rs. 245 - 285/kg

- Transplantation of seedlings has been completed in all major growing belts.
- As per initial reports, crop damages are expected in few growing belts due to sporadic rains.
- Water levels in all major reservoirs in the chilli growing belt are at sufficient level.
- Prices of all high colour and medium variety chilies have continued its firm trend.

- · New crop arrivals are expected in February.
- Regular finger turmeric prices have seen a stable trend in September.
- Salem Finger is currently traded at Rs. 70 72/kg
- Kocha availability is limited in domestic markets and prices remained stable to downward.
- Panangali turmeric prices were also reported stable to downward at main markets due to less demand.



INDONESIA.

- Turmeric prices have indicated a stable trend in September.
- · Crop arrivals are reported to be short.
- · Limited availability of quality materials.
- · Domestic and export demand is stable.
- Exports indicate an increase towards the end of September.
