

BLACK PEPPER

Global Market Scenario:

- Black pepper markets across the globe reported a stable trend during March 2023. Rising inflation and interest rates have affected the pepper trade adversely. Domestic and International demand continues to be down.
- Indian pepper price indicated a stable trend in March, contributed by Indian Rupee weakening against the US Dollar recording a 1% depreciation.
- Domestic and international prices for Indonesian pepper reported stable for March. Some farmers have finished their intermittent harvest in limited areas.
- Black pepper prices in Sri Lanka indicated a stable trend in March, partially contributed by the




weakening of the Sri Lankan Rupee against the US Dollar.

■ Black pepper prices in Vietnam responded stable this month due to stable demand.

- Market arrivals of new Indian black pepper crop has peaked.
- Indian black pepper prices have indicated a stable trend in March due to subdued demand.
- Domestic and International buyers are not actively buying.
- Ungarbled pepper was traded at Rs. 488/kg whereas garbled pepper was traded at Rs. 508/kg levels at domestic markets.

- Market arrivals have been fluctuating highly. The prices have been steadily increasing.
- Stockist have been very much active at field level and market level.
- Domestic and international buyers have been covering required volumes on regular basis.
 Extraction companies have also started procurement.
- Unseasonal rains were reported in the chilli growing areas. Harvested and standing crop is reported to be affected.

- Prices of Teja chilli varieties indicated a firm trend in domestic markets during March 2023.
- The current Teja red chilli prices have indicated an increase of 28-33 % when compared with 2022 price.
- Current market price of other major varieties is:

341/334 chilli : Rs. 210 - 230/kg 5531 red : Rs. 230 - 240/kg

 Prices of all high & medium colour varieties have indicated a firm trend in March.

 Panangali turmeric new crop arrival is expected by mid of April.

- The prices are further expected to firm up in the short term.
- Favourable export demand is supporting the price.
