- An active Western Disturbance likely to affect Western Himalayan Region from 29th February and plains of northwest India from 1st March to 3st March with peak intensity on 1st & 2st March, 2024. High moisture feeding from Arabian Sea to northwest India is also likely during 1st to 2st March under its influence.
- Fairfy widespread to widespread light/moderate rainfall accompanied with thunderstorms & lightning very likely over Western Himalayan Region during 1st - 3st March 2024.
- Scattered to widespread light/moderate rainfall accompanied with thunderstorms & lightning very likely over Punjab, Haryana-Chandigarh-Delhi and isolated to scattered light/moderate rainfall over Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan on 1st & 2nd March, 2024.
- Isolated heavy rainfall/snowfall very likely over Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit Baltistan-Muzaffarabad and Himachal Pradesh on 1st
 and isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall/snowfall on 2nd March 2024. Isolated heavy rainfall/snowfall also very likely over Uttarakhand and
 isolated heavy rainfall over Punjab on 02nd March 2024.
- Hailstorm activity also very likely at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand on 1st & 2st March; Rajasthan on 1st March and over Haryana Chandigarh, Punjab, and West Uttar Pradesh on 2st March 2024.
- Isolated to scattered light/moderate rainfall accompanied with thunderstorms, lightning, hailstorms, and gusty winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) very likely over Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Vidarbha, Odisha, Jharkhand, and Gangetic West Bengal on 27th February 2024.
- A Cyclonic circulation lies over northeast Bangladesh and neighbourhood in lower tropospheric levels. Under its influence isolated to scattered light/moderate rainfall/snowfall very likely over Arunachal Pradesh during next 6-7 days. Isolated light/moderate rainfall over the Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura on 28th February 2024.
- Hot and humid weather very likely to prevail over Rayalaseema during next 5 days and over Kerala during next 3 days.

BLACK PEPPER

Global Market Scenario

- Black pepper market in February indicated a mixed trend as the Chinese New Year was celebrated. Vietnam and Indonesian markets opened with a rather positive outlook whereas Sri Lankan origins reported with a steady trend.
- The Indian pepper price reported a slightly decreasing trend in February due to increased availability and slow demand.
- The Indonesian Rupiah strengthened against the US Dollar 1% appreciation, both local and international price for Indonesian pepper reported with an increasing trend in February.
- Sri Lankan pepper price reported a steady trend for February.
 - Domestic and international price for Vietnamese pepper reported an upward trend in February.

INDIA

- Black Pepper prices have indicated a slightly easing trend in February.
- Increased availability and subdued demand in the consuming markets had impacted the black pepper prices.
- As the local festival season comes to an end the demand had slowed down.
- Farmers and traders are holding stocks expecting the prices to firm up in the long run.
- Ungarbled pepper was traded at INR. 554/kg whereas garbled pepper was traded at INR. 574/kg levels at domestic markets.





INDONESIA

- · Prices had indicated a firm trend for February due to strong international and domestic demand.
- Indonesia pepper production has been affected by the climatic aberrations.
- · New pepper crop arrival is expected in July.
- · Valid offers are very limited.
- · Muntok White pepper prices has indicated a firm trend and availability is very limited.

VIETNAM

- The Vietnam pepper market indicated a firm trend in February.
- After TET holiday the market has opened with strong domestic and international demand.
- Farmers and traders are holding the stocks expecting the prices to further increase.
- Europe, Middle East and USA demand continues to be strong. China buyers are yet to be active in the market.

SRI LANKA

BLACK PEPPER SRI LANKA JAN FEB MAR APR MAY JUN JUL AUG SEP OCT NOV DEC

- Sri Lankan pepper prices indicated a steady trend in February.
- · The upcoming crop is reported to be good.
- · The local and international demand continues to be slow.
- · Stockists and traders are holding stocks expecting better prices.
- · Currently light pepper availability is very limited.



CHILLI

Season

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- The chilli arrivals in Guntur market were averaging at 1 lakh bags per day.
- · The market has been steady for most of the varieties.
- Second pick arrival has started coming to the market. Cap levels have been lower than expected.
- Western flower thrips pest infestation has been reported from some areas of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh. The quality and yielding of the crop have been affected in the concerned areas.
- Extraction companies and masala companies have been active in the market.



- · Medium quantity and high moisture material arrival is more in all the markets.
- Exporters are still active in the market. Stockists have been active in the market, expecting the price to firm up further.
- Prices of Teja chilli, mainly medium and best grades indicated a stable trend in domestic markets during February. The expectation is the prices will further firm up in coming months.
- · Current market price of other major varieties is:

341/334 Chilli : INR 170 -200/kg. 5531 Red : INR 150 -165/kg. Teja Red : INR 200 -205/Kg.

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- The chilli arrivals in Byadgi market were averaging at 2 2.5 lakh bags per market day in February.
- The climatic and pest incidences greatly affected the chilli yielding this season. 30 to 40 percent drop in yielding was
 reported from some of the growing belts.
- Major new crop arrivals are of KDL and colour variety. Moisture level in the current arrivals is at 15-18%.
- Prices have indicated a steady trend mainly for the high colour varieties.
- · Demand has been stable for the high & medium colour varieties, mainly from the powdering and masala companies.
- · Extraction companies and stockists have been actively buying in the market.

TURMERIC

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- · Regular finger turmeric prices have indicated a firm trend in February.
- · Turmeric crop is reported to be short by more than 30%.
- · Prices are firm and material availability is very low.
- Traders and farmers are stocking the material expecting the prices to further firm up.
- Salem Finger is currently traded at INR 130 -140/kg levels.
- · Kocha availability is very low.
- · Panangali availability is very low.



INDONESIA

- · Turmeric new crop arrival is expected in May.
- Climatic aberrations have adversely affected the turmeric cultivation.
- The crop is reported to be short by 20%.
- · The availability of firm offers is limited.



DRY GINGER

GINGER INDIA JAN FEB MAR APR MAY JUN JUL AUG SEP OCT NOV DEC

- Prices for premium quality dry ginger have indicated a firm trend in domestic markets in February.
- · Dry ginger material availability is very low.
- · High demand and low availability is sustaining the price.



NIGERIA

- The price of Nigerian ginger has continued the firm trend in February.
- · New crop offers are limited.
- Material currently available in the market is of mixed and inferior quality.



CELERY

- · Nutmeg and Mace new crop arrivals are expected in May.
- Indonesian BWP grade nutmeg prices have indicated a firm trend in February.
- The new crop arrival is expected in October November.
